UTM U12 – Big Show Rules 2019

- 1. Round-Robin & Playoff games are 7-innings or no new inning after 1:20. Umpire will communicate the start time of each game following the first pitch thrown.
- 2. Medal games are full 7-innings, or no new inning after 1:30. Umpire will communicate the start time of each game following the 1st pitch thrown
- 3. All pool games can end in a tie.
- 4. If the home team is ahead, they do not take their last AB's
- 5. If the home team is ahead, when time expires the game is over
- 6. Mercy rules are 15 after 3, 12 after 4, 10 after 5. No exceptions
- 7. ***There is a run-cap of 5-runs MAX in innings 1,2 & 3 of each game*** (pool games only)
- 8. All teams are encouraged to bat their entire line-up for this event
- 9. If a player is injured they can be removed from the line-up without penalty, but can't come back in that game at a later time.
- 10. A courtesy runner can be used for the pitcher & catcher at any time (last available). This isn't limited to only when there are 2-out. It is mean to ensure pitchers & catchers aren't injured on the bases. It is up to a team if they want to use this feature each time, or just in certain situations.
- 11. There is a max run differential of +/- 7 runs per game

Playoff Positioning

- 1. Tie breaker order of operations is as follows:
 - a. Head to Head
 - b. Run Differential (with a maximum +/- of 7 per game)
 - c. Least Runs Against
 - d. Most Runs Scored
- 2. The higher seed is the home team for all playoff games

Rain Policy

- 1. UTM will have a contingency plan in place for rain. It will be communicated to all affected teams as soon as we become aware of a situation in which one or more fields is deemed unplayable.
- 2. UTM can shorten game lengths if need be, or modify the format of the event as needed.
